Those reports must state the total number of In-Competition tests and Out-Of-Competition tests conducted within the nation for that year (further broken up into male and female numbers of tests) and the number of Anti-Doping Rule Violations occurring in the nation for that year, with the substance or method indicated for each case. The report must also state the identity of the laboratory or laboratories analysing samples for the nation for that year. **Failure by a National Federation to provide this**
