Please send your amendments according IPF-Con. 7.3.6.3 latest 13th September 2016 to the President, Secretary General and Law & Legislation Committee Chairman. Please keep in mind, that at this General Assembly the Constitution and By-Laws cannot be changed, except if the General Assembly decides about amendments with a 2/3-majority.

According to 9.2.3 of the IPF Constitution, the nominations of candidates for each IPF office shall be received by the President, the Secretary General and the Law and Legislation Committee at the latest, 45 days prior to the date of the General Assembly (28th September 2016) where the election shall take place. Late nominations shall not be accepted, except if there is no nomination for an IPF-Office. All nominations must be posted on the IPF Homepage at least 40 days prior to the General Assembly.
